Library Services During COVID

BPL is now open with some limits and requirements in place to meet MDHHS restrictions and keep staff and the public safe.

- In library visits may include:
 - Browsing/borrowing materials
 - Using library computers
 - Corner Book Shoppe purchases.
- Visits are limited to 20 minutes.
- Masks are required for entry unless you are fully vaccinated or under age 2. If this does not meet your needs, please contact us for other options.
- Capacity limit is 20 people (including staff) in the building at one time.
- Curbside pickup will continue.
- Free WiFi Access is accessible 24/7 from the parking lot, porch, and grounds.
- Toys, seating, and meeting space are NOT available at this time.
- Current requirements subject to change as guidelines change.



K'NEX STRUCTUTES: BRIDGES, KIT #17

Did you know you can borrow a K'nex bridge building kit from BPL? The K'nex Education- STEM Building Solution Bridge Kit is a highly fun and educational building toy designed for builders 8 and up. This kit contains the interlocking pieces and instructions to construct 13 different Bridge models. Each bridge option has simple instructions and a small write-up explaining its design concepts and a photo of a real world example. Each K'nex piece has a distinctive shape and color, making it easy to build the models, especially once you've built a couple. Once you get the hang of it, your imagination can run wild and you can build unlimited things!

Young hands will have fun for hours, while being completely engaged with the principles of structural engineering and the foundational principles of physics. There is also a teacher's guide to download for educators or anyone who wants to dig deeper into the world of engineering.
