The 3 year renovation process at the library was completed March 2017 and we could not be more pleased with the finished look. The final stage of renovations resulted in a new Young Adult section, updates to the staff room and a newly imagined space for the Children's Room, complete with a beautiful mural by Glenn Wolff, new shelving, a puppet theater and many hands on activities available to the children any time we are open. 


