

REMEMBERING BENZIE:

An Oral History Project March 2021 Update

Our student interns, Leola, Liam, and Olivia have been hard at work! Currently the Remembering Benzie student interns are working on their Legacy Project interviews.

The Legacy Project features interviews with Benzie County residents that have made an impact in our community. Each intern will interview two community members, one interviewee recommended by the Benzie Area Historical Society and one interviewee of their choice. Each session will result in one full, unedited video and one short, edited video focused on a point of interest from within the 1-2 hour unedited interview. The short video will include photos, B roll (secondary footage spliced in), and occasionally, music. Both the unedited, full interview and the edited, short video will be posted to the Remembering Benzie YouTube channel. Legacy Project videos will be released weekly on Tuesdays at 10am beginning April 6th.

CODE-A-PILLAR TWIST, KIT #8

The Code-a-pillar Twist is a fun and educational toy that features early coding and problem solving for preschoolers! Made by the good folks at Fisher-Price, this friendly caterpillar is full of lights, sounds, and surprises. Young minds will find enjoyment in guessing its animal noises, dancing along with its music and following its twisting movement. By selecting an action icon on each of its body segments, you are actually writing a code for the Code-a-pillar to follow. Will you send him through a room, pausing to chatter, eat and nap? Will you program a series of turns, songs, and animal sounds?

Dr. Fizz loves to discover new things to do with the Code-a-pillar Twist. His favorite activity is to draw a map of the room and try to program it to follow a path. He also likes to make it chase Mrs. McGoughy's cat.
