

3 in-person programs 163 kids registered 538 reading logs submitted 20 prize drawing winners

















LEAPFROG 100 ANIMALS BOOK

KIT #19, ages 18 months-4 years

Leap on over to the children's room and check out the LeapFrog 100 Animals Book! This learning tool from the groundbreaking LeapFrog company, is a #1 best-seller and patron favorite, and for good reason: It is amazing. Six double-sided, touch interactive pages feature animals from 12 different environments such as the forest, the ocean and the shore as an early introduction to science concepts. Kids can explore the book through three different play modes and hear the animal names read aloud, the sounds they make and learn fun facts. Flip the switch to learn new words for animals, habitats and facts in both English and Spanish. To really top it off, the 100 Animals Book plays three songs to emphasize all the fun and learning.
