Statewide eBook collection about Michigan and the Great Lakes Region *Free for MI residents & visitors*



A cooperative effort between <u>Library of Michigan</u> and the presses of <u>University of Michigan</u>, <u>Michigan State</u> <u>University</u>, and <u>Wayne State University</u> has launched a unique collection of regional eBooks available to all residents and visitors to Michigan. The *ReadMichigan.org* statewide eBook collection initially consists of 300 eBooks published by local university presses about Michigan and the Great Lakes region.

The homegrown collection includes winners of the prestigious <u>Michigan Notable Books</u> award as well as other important books published by Michigan presses and authors. Residents and visitors to the state of Michigan can access these eBooks (with no wait lists or holds) via geolocation at any time at <u>www.ReadMichigan.org</u>. <u>Michigan Humanities</u> has provided important financial support and is also a founding partner of the project.

Free eBooks, audiobooks, and magazines available on your device or computer

A fresh and easy way to borrow and read from your library. To provide users with a state-of-the-art reading experience, everything has shifted to the Libby App both on devices and computers. Anyone currently using the OverDrive App will be able to continue with it through most of 2022, but you are encouraged to switch to the Libby App. Visit **benzonialibrary.org** and click on the UpNorth Digital Collection.

- Simple, step-by-step onboarding the first time you open the app
- Start reading immediately after you borrow; no need to choose a file format
- See your at-a-glance progress through each book on your Shelf
- Add, remove, and rename cards from all your libraries in one place


