Helen Dewey Retires from Board of Trustees

Benzonia Public Library thanks her for her many years of invaluable service

After 10 years on the Benzonia Public Library Board of Trustees, Helen Dewey is retiring. Over Helen's 10 years of service the library board, staff, volunteers and public have benefitted from Helen's love of the library, her knowledge, attention to detail and willingness to research, gather and share information. We are all so grateful for everything we have learned from Helen and for her years of dedication and friendship.

We asked Helen to share a snapshot of her time in "library land" and she kindly provided the following insight!

Helen's mother was a school librarian, and Helen sometimes helped where her mother worked. Helen became interested in becoming a librarian when the library they used near her husband Roger's Navy grad school was able to borrow all the Wizard of Oz books for her older daughter through "Interlibrary Loan." Wow, libraries had more services than she realized before!

When the Navy moved them to Washington, DC, Helen applied to library school graduate programs in the area. She entered the U of MD School of Library Science in 1983 - attending at night part time while raising 2 young children. She graduated with a Master of Library Science degree in 1985 and volunteered in the Fairfax County Public Library, VA, system. Soon, FCPL started opening branches on Sundays, and she was hired for the 14-hour/week Sundays Plus program as an Information Services Librarian-1 in a Regional Library less than two miles from home. She would ride her bicycle to work in good weather.

Helen found her calling in helping people find the answers to their questions. (Librarians don't have to know everything; they just need to know how to find answers about everything!) At library conferences, she learned "Readers' Advisory" skills to help people find more books similar to ones they have enjoyed. Although not officially a "children's librarian," Helen was delighted that FCPL trained her in "Book Talking" to get kids enthusiastic about reading by piquing their interest in a wide assortment of books.

Until her retirement in 2004, Helen worked part-time at FCPL -20 hours or more, depending on other assignments such as working in the Collection Management department selecting books covering topics requested by library users.

After Roger and Helen moved to Benzie County in 2004, she volunteered in the Frankfort-Elberta Middle/High School library, the Benzonia Public Library, and the Benzie Shores District Library. Her proudest accomplishment was organizing a Summer Reading Program which awarded booklets of coupons from local merchants to all school age children in the county (and summer visitors) who accomplished reading goals over the summer. She "book talked" in every elementary and middle

school in the county before she had to cut back due to losing energy and vision.

Helen learned about serving on a Board as the representative of Benzie and Leelanau Counties on the Mid-Michigan Library League (cooperative) Board for 4 years. When Benzonia Township residents became eligible in 2012, she won election to the BPL Board of Trustees. Her years of public library experience proved invaluable in this role.

In 2014, Helen became BPL Treasurer. Her first task was to learn how to use QuickBooks. Gradually, and with advice from the biennial auditor, she became proficient in keeping the library's accounts. Unfortunately, health issues led her to resign in 2022. Helen has shared her knowledge with new BPL Treasurer Diana Heller who is quickly learning the nuances of library accounting.
