- **Reading often makes you kinder:** Studies have shown that people who read more fictional books are more likely to be kinder to others than people who don't.
- **Reading fast helps your eyes:** Reading a book fast will help to strengthen your vision.
- It reduces stress: A good book can be a great stress reliever if you allow yourself to get lost in the book.
- It improves your vocabulary: Reading good books often will help to improve your vocabulary as you would be coming across new words.
- Your creativity is increased: Consistent reading will help to increase your imagination, which will stimulate your brain to develop new ideas and make you more creative.

National Reading Month is celebrated in March. In this month people, especially children, read a lot more. An increase in reading has significant benefits that will continue to pay off in the future. 
Meetings are held at 4:30 pm the 1st Thursday every other month in the library building.
